## New Food Box System - Expect Delays, Free Socks

On January 2, 2017, CSC will implement a new system for food boxes. This system will require a one-time intake that may take longer. We are implementing this system to better serve you and to improve the quality of services at CSC. The food options available to you will remain the same.

If you can stop by the front desk to do your intake Monday-Thursday morning, this will help us to expedite afternoon service. We will provide you with a free hat, pair of socks, and/or gloves for your trouble.

#### **Hours Changes**

- Coordinated Housing Access is now at CSC on Tuesdays from 2:30-4 p.m., NOT Thursdays. They will show up at 1 p.m. on days when the resource fair occurs.
- Nightwatch on Saturday is now 4-8, with dinner served at 6.
- Outside In Oregon Health Plan Support is now 1-4 Tuesdays.
- Bus Tickets are now only available during food box hours in the afternoon.

#### **Staff Office Hours**

Staff members Julie and Rob are adjusting their policy on providing assistance to clients. They will provide bus tickets, SNAP assistance, and other services to clients during food box hours only. In the morning, they will not provide bus tickets or other assistance.

## SNAP (Food Stamp) Application Support

Starting **January 1, 2017**, able-bodied adults without dependents in Clackamas County will have food stamp privileges limited. To find out more information or learn about possible exemptions to this rule, you can visit us during office hours.
