Job Description:

This is a dynamic position in a small, rapidly growing nonprofit. We are looking for someone who can manage our warehouse receiving operations to improve processes and produce results in a fast-paced, person-oriented environment.

Responsibilities:

- Oversees food flow in and out of warehouse
 - Grocery delivery pick ups
 - Donation drop offs
 - Food share partner program
- Tracking incoming and outgoing food poundage
 - Will report these stats to Director of Food Operations at first of each month
- Managing inventory
 - Includes food ordering to sustain inventory
- Assisting and co-managing volunteers
 - Will include flexing into volunteer positions as needed
- Identify and improve processes, increase efficiency and effectiveness of food programs
- Reports to Director of Food Operations
 - Includes weekly/monthly tasks
- Maintains positive relationships with partners, donors and volunteers
- Assist in food sourcing
- Assist in monitoring inventory
- Collaborate and work well with small staff, volunteers, community partners, and larger community
- All other duties as assigned

Required qualifications:

- This job can be very physical - must be able to lift up to 40-50 pounds, routinely receive large donations, pack boxes, etc.
- Must be organized and detail-oriented with an ability to think about the bigger picture and holistic health of the clients, the warehouse, and the community
- Must be a self-starter with an ability to take initiative and work with minimal supervision
- Willingness to be flexible, innovative, thoughtful, and creative
- Strong interpersonal communication and relationship building skills
- Ability to work with a variety of people, including community members, volunteers, staff, and clients
- Ability to work independently as well as part of a team
- Basic knowledge of food safety and nutrition
- Basic knowledge and passion for food security, homelessness issues, and/or socioeconomic justice
- Basic proficiency with typing, Microsoft Office, and Google Drive

Preferred qualifications:

- Experience in food pantry coordination or nonprofit work
- Experience with process improvement and system building
- Experience working with marginalized populations
